"You meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today." – Genesis 50:20

Remember the story of Joseph and his amazing technicolor coat? The coat that his father Jacob gave him. The coat that made his brothers, the other sons of Jacob, despise him. Remember how his brothers beat him, threw him in a pit, and sold him into slavery?

While enslaved in Egypt, Joseph was accused of inappropriate behavior with his master's wife. Joseph was taken away to rot in prison. And there he sat until Pharoah had a dream. By God's grace Joseph interpreted that dream and saved not only the Egyptians but all the surrounding peoples. Now, I say by God's grace Joseph interpreted the dream. But all of it; the coat, the pit, the slavery, the prison time; was all by God's grace. At the end of the story Joseph's brothers, now living in Egypt with him, begged him not to repay them for their evil acts. And Joseph said, "You meant evil against me, but God meant it for good."

This Lenten season we will be exploring this idea of God using our evil acts for His good. Joseph saved thousands, if not millions, because of his brothers' evil acts. And in doing so God shows us, in Genesis, a model for how He will operate. It's this same model that plays out in the Gospel of Luke as Jesus' brothers, the Priests, Scribes, and Pharisees, plot to arrest and kill the son of Joseph. They too beat him. They too wrap him in a colorful robe. And Jesus like Joseph before Him in Egypt is crowned, not with gold but with thorns.

Join us for our mid-week services this Lent to walk with Jesus as He suffers evil at the hands of His brothers. And as we know all too well, as He suffers because of our own evil deeds and sin. But what we meant for evil: God meant for good. Jesus suffered to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as you are today.

The Lenten season begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14th. And yes, that is Valentine's Day. A day normally set aside to tell those closest to us of our love for them. A day where we also remember Saint Valentine who was martyred for the faith which he preached and confessed. But Ash Wednesday is a not a day where we show our love for God by giving Him chocolate candies, instead we give Him the evil of our sin, and in return He gives us the love of a Savior.
