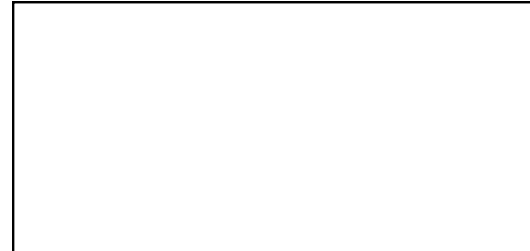

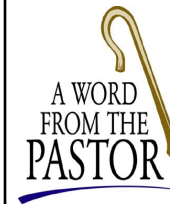

I wonder how the disciples took Jesus' response: "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by His own authority." In other words, you don't need to know. Jesus says, "What you need to know is this: you will receive the Holy Spirit. And with His power you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

As Christians we live in a world between. On one hand, we schedule our lives to make sure that kids are taken care of, responsibilities are fulfilled, and we have time for rest. But on the other hand, we must live as though Christ will be coming back tomorrow. What does that mean?

It means that we take on the tasks given to the disciples. You and I are not necessarily called to be His witnesses to Jerusalem and Judea. Instead, we switch Jerusalem for the ballpark, and Judea for the campgrounds in the Black Hills. We live out our schedules and go where those schedules take us. And it is in those places where we live out our witness to Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

So, enjoy the coming summer. Good luck on your planning and scheduling. Plan your trip to the beach or the mountains. At the same time prepare for the everlasting vacation to come.
