

By the end of this month school will be back in session. A very welcome return to the routines of regular life for many of us,

or a jarring wake-up call from the lazy, hazy dog days of summer for others.

For this new year we roll out a new theme upon which we will meditate in the church and school. *Real*.

Present. God. This theme also coincides with this year's Lutheran Schools Week and the LCMS Youth Gathering, which will be held in Minneapolis on July 11-15, 2019. The focus for our next year will be Psalm 46.

This famous Psalm begins in celebration of the mighty deeds of God "our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." It emphasizes not just his nearness to us but something more: His allencompassing presence and protection that constantly surround us.

St. Paul has a consistent way of emphasizing this throughout his epistles, picturing us "In Christ." Not simply "near Jesus," or "with Jesus" or even "Jesus in me." Don't get me wrong, these are all true, but "In Christ" pushes us in much deeper. All the way.

There is no part of me that is not encompassed by Him. No part of my life that is separate from Him. Nothing that I do is hidden from Him. What a sobering reminder for us to guard our attitude, watch our actions, and curb our tongues.
