


# What a wonderful start to our *Christ's Way*Capital Campaign!

### For We Live By Faith, Not By Sight

#### A Story of Stewardship by Hope Rose

When I met my husband, Nathan, I felt my prayers had been answered. He had three sons, and our family was complete. But one day, I felt a strong urge to grow our family. I shared my feelings with Nathan. He was unsure if this was our path to take. I prayed for peace and decided to give these feelings to God.

A few months passed. Then one day, Nathan told me he had thought long and hard about what I had said. And he agreed: it was time for us to grow our family. We started our adoption process.

First we met with an international adoption agency. We encountered road blocks with every single country's adoption guidelines. We were frustrated and discouraged. But now, looking back, we know that God was leading us to our daughter.

During this time we leaned on our church family. We sought support and advice from Jon and Lynette Epp, who themselves had walked the adoption road not long before. We eventually found a domestic adoption agency. For three years, we prayed. At times, we felt that an adoption might not happen. But we never lost faith. We trusted that the right child would come to us. Our church family supported us in prayer and presence, encouraging us in our faith.

#### A Message from Your Campaign Chairs

#### Sacrificial Giving: Meeting the need, then going beyond

We are starting the third month of the *Christ's Way* Campaign, and we are hitting it out of the park! We have already received well over \$200,000 of the \$1.5 million pledged. We love to report this kind of news!

At the same time, our general fund has taken a hit on regular giving. This news is hard to share but it is necessary. The church and school still must be able to pay its bills ("keep the lights on") and pay its staff (including teachers, janitors, administrative assistant, DCE and pastor).

This is the time for sacrificial giving. What does that mean? It means pushing outside of your comfort zone and asking what you might be willing to give up (sacrifice) in order to see our collective vision come to fruition. It might mean giving up one dinner out per month for the next year and putting the \$50 you would have spent on that dinner into the offering plate. It might mean less frequent trips through the coffee drive-through, or waiting just a little while longer before you trade in a reliable vehicle for newer, shinier wheels. It means seeking *Christ's Way* through prayer to help us expand HIS ministry, using the resources that are His to begin with.

If we are going to realize our vision to build a new gym and seven new classrooms, refurbish our current sanctuary and expand the narthex, it is going to take all of us. And, it is going to take all of us giving beyond the status quo, thinking outside the box, trusting the Lord to meet our needs as we return to Him the fruits of our labor.

First and foremost, our church and school needs your regular giving to the general fund, to sustain the ministry and operations we already have. IF you are able and willing to give beyond that tithe, only then would we ask for your help in supporting the Capital Campaign.

The mission before us is not easy. But we are a family with big goals, a family that sees the incredible potential of our church, school and preschool on the hill. We have a tremendous opportunity to serve our neighbors as more and more families seek educational options and a loving place to belong.
