

#### Christ's Way Capital Campaign is going strong!

God's blessing to all of you! After our first six months of the *Christ's*Way Capital Campaign, we are going strong. We have hosted some incredibly successful events over the last few months that have added financially to the campaign, as well as provided a lot of fun for our congregation and school community. Be on the lookout for upcoming events for the *Christ's Way*Campaign through the rest of the year.

Also, don't forget to check out the floorplan in the Narthex periodically. We have been coloring a graphic to show the amount we've raised as the dollars continue to come in. It's a fun and visual way to track our progress!

As a reminder, to move forward with the expansion, we need to have in hand 55% of the building cost, as well as a positive cash flow for our General Fund. We love our church and school staff at Zion, and roughly 90% of our annual budget supports them. We must remember that, before we can expand our ministry, our current ministry needs our attention! After struggling all year long with our budget, we ended the year with a loss of just over (\$21,000). To pay our monthly bills, we have had to dip into our dedicated funds. We cannot afford to keep doing this. We now have to pay ourselves back what we used from these funds, as well as maintain enough income to pay for our day-toChrist's Way Capital Campaign Pledged Amount \$1,586,461.00



day operations. We cannot expect to expand our ministry until the funding for our current ministries is under control. We can and will do this, but we need to do it together, as a church-and-school family! ## What is Discipleship?



Discipleship is a term that refers to the way students were taught in Jesus' day. Jesus had 12 disciples who followed Him everywhere and learned from Him as He interacted with them and others around them. Those disciples were then able to teach others when Jesus ascended to heaven.

Zion recently combined the boards of Outreach and Stewardship to become one Board of Discipleship. This combining of boards was for both practical reasons and to emphasize our relationship with Jesus as one not only about knowing Him, but also following Him. Jesus said, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And look, I am with you always to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20).

Discipleship shows our relationship with Jesus is one of continually learning from Him (Bible study and regular weekly worship) and putting into practice what He has taught us (love and service to others), as He Himself daily walks with us.

What does this have to do with the Capital Campaign? The growth of our church depends on each of us growing in our own spiritual walk. How are you growing spiritually? Are you attending a Bible study? Are you serving others? Are you attending and participating in weekly worship services? The Board of Discipleship is here to help you connect to opportunities to know Jesus, grow in your faith and serve in love.
